

## Optional Tests

### Visual Field Testing

The Visual Field is a computerized mapping of your peripheral vision. It determines if there is any vision loss. It is used in diagnosing several eye conditions and systemic illnesses. Our Doctor recommends this test every 2 years. The test itself only takes a few minutes. This test screens for: Glaucoma, certain tumors of the brain, Multiple Sclerosis and /or Circulatory problems/ Strokes.

Unfortunately, routine eye examinations do not detect some diseases at their early stage. The test is capable of discovering certain vision loss at an earlier stage than previous testing methods. It is important for those who have a personal or family history of glaucoma, retinal problems or vision loss.

### Fundus Photo

Digital Retinal Photography can be used to take a "picture" of the "back" of the eye (the retina or the "fundus"). A baseline picture of the retina helps to make a more accurate assessment of the changes in the eye from one examination to another.

This test is recommended for all the patients, especially those with glaucoma, macular degeneration, diabetes, high blood pressure, high cholesterol, or with a family history of glaucoma or retinal problems.

### Dilation

In order to thoroughly examine the inside of the eyes for disease and abnormalities, this office recommends that you have your pupils dilated (enlarged). This is easily done with medical drops. The enlarged pupils allow for a more complete view of the inner structures of the eye. This is important in detecting serious vision and health problems such as Glaucoma, Diabetes and retinal abnormalities.

There are some minor side effects associated with dilation. These include light sensitivity and blurred near vision that lasts several hours. We will provide you with disposable sunglasses to wear home if you have none of your own. **Contrary to what you may have heard, there should be little or no difficulties driving while your eyes are dilated.**
